JR. BHAM SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

In order to be eligible for the Jr. BHAM Scholarship you must meet and complete the following criteria:

- Have been an active BHAM member for at least one year prior and have qualified for year end awards.
- Attend and participate in 16 out of the 20 Weekend <u>BHAM</u> shows of the current year (4 out of 5 weekends) by the end of the September show.
- Have been an active Jr. BHAM member for at least one year prior and qualified for the Jr. BHAM year end gift.
- Actively participate in the Jr. BHAM youth program during the current year.
- Be in the ABRA Youth 14-18 or ALL COLOR Youth 14-18 division the current year you are applying for the scholarship.
- Have acquired at least a 3.0/B average or above for the year just completed in high school or college.
- Write a 100-400 word essay that is double-spaced in response to the following: How do you think your involvement with horses has helped equip you for the challenges you will face as you become an adult and strive to achieve your chosen career goals?
- Complete the Jr. BHAM Scholarship Application and submit it along with your essay to the Jr. BHAM Director on or before Saturday of the June BHAM show.
- Attend a formal interview with the Jr. BHAM Scholarship Selection Committee. The date will be announced and every effort made to accommodate applicant's schedule.
- Volunteer at least 8 hours between August 16, 2012 and August 15, 2013. Upon the completion of required hours a Volunteer Review must be completed and signed by a person of authority reporting on your attitude and work ethic. This review must then be sent to the BHAM secretary by the person completing the form and be postmarked no later than August 15. Possible volunteer opportunities could include but not be limited to a church mission project, community service project, Jr. BHAM service project, local food bank, handicapped riders association, BHAM shows, etc...
- Upon winning the scholarship, the funds shall be dispersed to the recipient made payable to the student <u>and</u> the university, college or trade school, at the time a letter of acceptance from said institution of higher learning is presented to the BHAM treasurer on or before December 31st of the year of the scholarship winner's 19th birthday. If there is a failure to produce said letter by the date specified, the funds are forfeited back to the Jr. BHAM Scholarship Fund.
